Most of the reference material on Spanish language and literature can be found in the Reference Room on the 1st floor of Mullen Library (non-circulating). The call number ranges for Spanish language is PC 4001-PC 4977 and Spanish literature PQ 6001 – PQ 8929. Circulating material is found in the Mullen Library stacks. Check the WRLC catalog: <http://catalog.wrlc.org> for monographs and journals that could be applicable to your topic. Check *CU's e-Journals* for online journal articles.

Abstracts, Bibliographies and Indices for Spanish Studies

Clase/Periodica

CLASE indexes documents published in Latin American journals in the social sciences and humanities from 1975 to the present. PERIODICA covers journals specializing in science and technology from 1978 to the present. Offers access to more than 300,000 bibliographic citations from documents published in 2,600 scholarly journals published in the Spanish, Portuguese, French and English languages. "Contains information from articles, essays, book reviews, monographs, conference proceedings, technical reports, interviews and brief notes published in journals edited in 24 different countries of Latin America and the Caribbean, as well as from publications that focus on Pan-American issues."

Literary Reference Center

Literary Reference Center is a full text database that combines information from major reference works, books, and literary journals. The LRC contains: "full text for 26,000 plot summaries, synopses and work overviews, nearly 100,000 articles/essays of literary criticism, 140,500 author biographies (including 14,300 in-depth bios), 350 literary journals, 530,000 book reviews, 32,000 classic and contemporary poems, 13,500 classic and contemporary short stories, and 4,000 author interviews."

MLA International Bibliography

Subjects covered include: criticism, language, linguistics, literature, film, speech, rhetoric, communication theory, interpersonal communication, drama, and folklore. Coverage begins in 1925 with the indexing of citations from over 4000 journals as well as series, monographs, dissertations, bibliographies, proceedings and other materials. This resource is the database of choice for all critical scholarship in languages research regardless of scholarly field. The print version (REF PB 5.9 .M69 M6) begins in 1921 and is available in the 1st floor Reference room.

General Abstracts, Bibliographies and Indices

Academic Search Premier (ALADIN) (Some Full Text)

Multi-subject reference source covering general and academic periodicals; full-text is available for many articles. Over 12,600 journals represented. Some journals are indexed back to 1965.

ArticleFirst (ALADIN)

An index of articles from nearly 12,500 journals across a variety of subjects and disciplines. 1990 – present.

Electronic Collections Online (ALADIN) (Some Full Text)

ECO is a multidisciplinary database that contains citations to over 4100 journals of varying dates of coverage. Basic, advanced and expert search features are available.

Historical Abstracts and America: History and Life (ALADIN)

Search both databases simultaneously. Covers articles, books, and dissertations on world history, American history and Canadian history (1450 to the present).

JSTOR (ALADIN) (Full Text)

The JSTOR project is a digital archive of fully searchable back issues of scholarly journals in many subjects. There are some journals in Latin American Studies and Spanish journals in language and literature.

LEXIS-NEXIS Academic Universe (ALADIN) (Full Text)

Provides timely news, business, and legal information, including: company, industry, government, and political news; company financial information; country and state profiles; and legal reviews and federal case. Spanish newspapers, magazines and wire services include: ABC, Agence France Presse – Spanish, ANSA Noticiero en español, Aseguranza, Business News Americas – Spanish, Business Wire Español, Channel Partner Spain, Cinco Dias, CNN en Espanol, Companynewsgroupe (Espanol), Computer Idea Spain, Computing España Spain, Conexion, Deutsche Presse-Agentur (Spanish), Diario Montañés, Diario Vasco, El Comercio, El Correo, El Mundo, El Norte (Mexico), El Norte de Castilla, El Pais, Expansion (MADRID), Global Broadcast Database – Español, Hoy, Ideal, Informe Latinoamericano, Informes Especiales, IPS - Inter Press Service – Spanish, La Opinion, La Rioja, La Verdad, La Voz de Cádiz, Latin Trade (Spanish), Latina, Mural (Mexico), NoticiasFinancieras, Palabra (Mexico), PC Actual Spain, PC Pymes Spain, PR Newswire en espanol, PR Newswire Europe (Spanish), Redes & Telecom Spain, Reforma (Mexico), Spanish Newswire Services (Efe News Services), Sur, Thomson Financial News Espana Super Focus, UPI Chile, UPI LatAm, UPI Reporte LatAm, vnunet.es, WorldSources, Inc, Emerging Markets Datafile, and Xinhua News Agency – Spanish. The coverage of these titles may be incomplete or sporadic.

Proquest (Periodical Abstracts) (ALADIN) (Some Full Text)

Multi-subject reference source covering general and academic periodicals; full-text is available for many journals. Current news to historical events. 1971 – present.

WorldCat (OCLC Catalog)

OCLC *WorldCat* database is the OCLC online catalog. It contains over 61 million titles and over 1 billion records describing library holdings in the United States, Canada, and a highly selective list of European, Asian, and African institutions. This is an excellent database for acquiring correct bibliographic citations and locating copies of a title in the DC area.
