Subject and individual philosopher bibliographies are spread through out the call number range. Some examples: the primary texts of medieval philosophers such as Augustine and Aquinas can be found in the range BQ 5732-6889; philosophy of science can be found in the range Q 174-180. Your best bet: check the WRLC catalog at <http://catalog.wrlc.org> for monographs and journals that could be applicable to your topic. Check the *CU's e-journals* for full text journal articles online.

Bibliographies and Indices specific to Philosophy

Bibliographie de la philosophie (CD-ROM & Print)

Paris, Librairie Philosophique J. Vrin, 1937-present. Annotated bibliography of philosophical literature. Languages include: English, French, German. 1937 – present. Use the print version as the CD-ROM only covers 1998-2000. **T/P B 33 .I61**

Philosopher's Index (ALADIN & Print)

Citations to books and journals in philosophy and its subjects (including aesthetics, epistemology, ethics, logic, metaphysics, and the philosophy of selected disciplines). 1940 - present. Book reviews begin in 1993. Over 550 journals indexed. The call number for the print version is **T/P B 33.6 .P54** in 314 Mullen.

Répertoire bibliographique de la philosophie (Online & Print)

Louvain-la-Neuve : Editions de l'Institut supérieur de philosophie, Université catholique de Louvain, 1949-present. The full title is: *International philosophical bibliography/Répertoire bibliographique de la philosophie/Bibliografisch repertorium van de wijsbegeerte*. Languages included: Dutch, English, French, German, Italian,

Latin, Portuguese, Spanish and Catalan. The *Répertoire* also has over 550 journals indexed. The 4th issue has an index to book reviews included in the same volume. The call number for the print version is **T/P B 33 .R42 1949** in 314 Mullen. This title does go back to 1934 as a supplement of the *Revue néoscholastique de philosophie*. This period of coverage from 1934-1945 can be found in *Bibliographia Philosophica 1934-1945* (**T/P B 33 .B85**). There are two *IPB* databases: a retrospective one that begins in the early 1980's and a current database that covers from 1997 to the present. You may find these databases in ALADIN under *International Philosophical Bibliography*.

Subject specific Abstracts, Bibliographies and Indices relevant to Philosophy

L'Annee philologique (ALADIN)

Critical and analytical bibliography of Greek and Roman Antiquity. Ancient Greek philosophers but also thinkers from late antiquity and the early Medieval period. 1949 - present. Print version from 1924. **T/P PA 29 .A61**

ATLA Religion (ALADIN)

The ATLA Religion Database, produced by the American Theological Library Association (ATLA), is a comprehensive reference tool designed to support religious and theological scholarship in graduate education and faculty research. The database consists of more than 1.5 million records covering the research literature of religion in over 30 languages from 1,633 journals (518 currently indexed) and 18,700 multi-author works in and related to the field of religion. The database covers 1949 to the present with a few journals going back to the mid 1800's. Over 100 journals with full text.

Catholic Periodical and Literature Index (ALADIN)

Over 419,000 citations to articles published in more than 160 Roman Catholic periodicals, as well as essays, books, and book reviews on Catholic Church history and contemporary issues. Provides complete indexing of papal documents. Coverage begins in 1981 for over 200 journals and continues to the present. The print version begins in 1930. **T/P AI 3 .C3**.

In Principio: Incipit Index of Latin Texts (CD-ROM)

A searchable index of over 700,000 Latin incipits covering Latin literature from the pre-classical age to the Renaissance.

Index Islamicus (CD-ROM)

“A bibliography of publications on Islam and the Muslim world from 1906 to 1999. An index to the worldwide literature in European languages on Islam, the Middle East and the Muslim world. Covers all aspects of the life and thought of Muslims past and present, including architecture, art, education, history, law, literature, philosophy, religion, sciences, social sciences, politics, and current affairs, in the Middle East, Muslim areas of Asia and Africa, and Muslim minorities around the world.” (CD-ROM is located in the MERIC Lab with the print in the Semitics Library).

Index Philosophicus (CD-ROM)

A humanities and social sciences database with citations to journal articles, book reviews, and festschriften in philosophy, psychology, theology, religion and other disciplines. Covers 1983 to present citations from IBZ (*Internationale Bibliographie der Zeitschriftenliteratur*), IBR (*Internationale Bibliographie der Rezensionen aus allen Gebieten des Wissens*) and IJBF (*Internationale Jahresbibliography der Festschriften*). European emphasis with only 50% of the citations referencing English material. Print versions of IBZ (**AI 9 .B59**) and IBR (**Z 5051 .I65**) are available in the 2nd floor Reading Room. 1983 – present.

International Medieval Bibliography (ALADIN)

A citation index to the European Middle Ages (400-1500). Disciplines covered include: Art History, Classics, English Language and Literature, Medieval European Languages and Literatures, History, Archaeology, Theology, Philosophy, Arabic and Islamic Studies, Music, Theatre and Performance Arts, Rhetoric and Communication Studies. No book reviews or monographs. 1967 – present. Search *The Bibliographie de civilisation médiévale* and the *IMB* simultaneously. The print version can be found in Room 316. **T/P CB 1 .I61.**

Iter (ALADIN)

A bibliographic database pertaining to the Middle Ages and Renaissance (400-1700); over 1700 journal titles published since 1784 are indexed in such fields as medieval and renaissance studies, philosophy, religious studies, music, literature, and general humanities. Quite a lot of canon law material can be found. Also check *Iter Italicum*, the online version of Paul Oskar Kristeller's work published between 1963 and 1992 that lists uncatalogued or incompletely catalogued Renaissance humanistic manuscripts found in libraries and collections all over the world. Citations to canonical works are given.

Latin Bibliography (CD-ROM)

This bibliography contains over 395,000 titles from around 140 countries spanning from the 15th century to present day. It lists theological, philosophical and scientific treatises and dissertations, works of European Humanism, official ecclesiastical writings, Latin Bible translations, works of Church patriarchs, literature of the middle Ages and writings of Roman antiquity.

MLA International Bibliography (ALADIN)

Produced by the Modern Language Association of America, the *MLA International Bibliography* indexes critical scholarship on literature, language, linguistics, drama and theater, and folklore. Coverage includes journal articles, series, monographs, dissertations, bibliographies, proceedings and other materials. The database includes all records indexed from 1925 to the present, approximately 2 million records. The print version begins in 1921 **REF PB 5.9.M69 M6**

General Abstracts, Bibliographies and Indices

Academic Search Premier (some full text)

Multi-subject reference source covering general and academic periodicals; full-text is available for many articles. Over 12,600 journals represented. Some journals are indexed back to 1965.

ArticleFirst

An index of articles from nearly 16,000 journals across a variety of subjects with over 23 million citation records. One of the main subjects is philosophy. 1990 – present.

Humanities International Complete (ALADIN)

A comprehensive database of humanities content, providing full text of hundreds of journals, books and other published sources from around the world. This database includes all data from *American Humanities Index* and *Humanities International Index* (over 1.6 million records) plus unique full text content.

Proquest (Periodical Abstracts) (some full text)

Multi-subject reference source covering general and academic periodicals; full-text is available for many journals. Current news to historical events. 1971 – present.

WorldCat (OCLC Catalog)

OCLC *WorldCat* database is the OCLC online catalog. It contains over 107 million titles and over one billion records describing library holdings. This is an excellent database for acquiring correct bibliographic citations and locating copies of a title in the DC area.

Primary Texts of Philosophers

Archive of Celtic-Latin Literature (CD-ROM)

The corpus of Latin literature produced in Celtic-speaking Europe and the Latin works of the "peregrini" on mainland Europe during the period 400 - 1200 A.D. These texts span a variety of fields including theology, liturgy, grammar, hagiography, poetry, and historiography. A handful of philosophers are represented (e.g. Peter Abelard). Document types include legal texts, charters, and inscriptions.

Bibliotheca Teuberiana Latina (CD-ROM)

Database of over 500 complete works in Latin literature covering the Roman Republic to the Imperial Period and Late Antiquity (300 BCE to 500 AD).

Library of Latin Texts (ALADIN)

This database comprises almost all works published in the *Corpus Christianorum*, both the *Series Latina* and *Continuatio Mediaevalis* (approximately 70% of the database), *Bibliotheca scriptorum Romanorum Teubneriana* and 600,000 words for the modern period. Selected works from the following series are also present: *Corpus Scriptorum Ecclesiasticorum Latinorum*, *Sources Chrétiennes*, *Migne's Patrologia*, *Acta Sanctorum*, *Analecta Hymnica Medii Aevi*. The print version begins with **T/P BQ310. C.67**.

Past Masters (CD-ROM)

Past Masters series which include the works of Aristotle, Aquinas, Anselm, Augustine, Hobbes, Kant, Leibniz, Berkeley, Hume, and Sidgwick.

Patrologia Latina (ALADIN)

Works of the Church Fathers from Tertullian in 200 AD to Pope Innocent III in 1216. The print version is called 'Patrologiae cursus completus' editor J.-P. Migne 1844-1865. Two series, 'Series Latina' (221 v.) & 'Series Graeca' (161 v). **T/P BQ 310 .M351**.

Patrologiae Graecae (ALADIN)

Works of the Church Fathers in Greek with Latin translations covering the Apostolic Fathers to the Council of Florence 1439. **T/P BQ 310 .M34.**

Thesaurus Linguae Graecae (ALADIN)

Contains texts in Greek literature from the eighth century BCE to 600 AD. Also has historiographical, lexicographical, and scholastic texts from the period between 600 and 1453 AD.

Thesaurus Linguae Latinae (CD-ROM)

The TLL is the premier Latin dictionary. Entries included in this edition cover the letter ranges A to P. The print version can be found in the Greek and Latin Seminar Room in the folios section (**G & L PA 2361 .T41**)

Thomae Aquinatis Opera Omnia (CD-ROM)

The entirety of the works of St. Thomas Aquinas in Latin. *Index Thomisticus* is available in the Religious Studies/Philosophy Library folios. **T/P BQ 6879 .B96 folios** . You may want to examine the *Corpus Thomisticum* website as well:

Dissertation Abstracts International (ALADIN)

Indexes every doctoral dissertation completed in the U.S. at accredited institutions since 1861, with full-text from 1996-present for CUA and many other academic institutions. If you want to purchase a dissertation, go through our Access Services department (1st floor Mullen) as it is cheaper than buying online directly.
